

2024 DEEP FREEZE PICKLEBALL TOURNAMENT AT MCC

NOVICE BRACKET 2.5-3.0 SKILL LEVEL

1:30pm - Arrive at MCC front desk for member/non-member check-in. Proceed to the gym to check-in for the tournament and begin warming up.

2pm - Round Robin portion of the tournament begins. You will play the 5 other teams once each to determine seeding for the single elimination bracket.

4pm - Tournament wraps up

INTERMEDIATE BRACKET 3.5+ SKILL LEVEL

5:30pm - Arrive at MCC front desk for member/non-member check-in. Proceed to the gym to check-in for the tournament and begin warming up.

6pm - Round Robin portion of the tournament begins. You will play the 5 other teams once each to determine seeding for the single elimination bracket.

8pm - Tournament wraps up

Tournament Rules:

- **This tournament will mirror similar play of our Tuesday night pickleball group, where the purpose is to have fun while getting some exercise and enjoying some friendly competition.**
 - Games will be played on the honor system. If teams do not agree on a call, you can opt for a replay or you can call over a tournament director to help determine a path to move forward with the game.
 - Clearly call out the score before each serve. If there is a discrepancy in the score, pause to figure it out before resuming the game.
- Determining sides and first serve:
 - During the Round Robin portion, a coin will be flipped to determine sides and 1st serves. The winner of the coin toss can either choose which side of the court they want OR if they want first serve. The coin toss loser will choose from the remaining option.
 - During the Bracket portion, the higher seeded team will either choose which side of the court they want OR if they want first serve. The lower seeded team will choose from the remaining option.
- Round Robin Games will be played to 11 points, win by 2. Bracket games will be played to 15 points, win by 2. The Championship game for 1st and 2nd place will be best 2 out of 3 games, to 15 points, win by 2.
- One player from each team will see the tournament director following each game to record scores.
- Balls, nets and paddles are provided by MCC (you may also opt to bring your own paddle).

Please note: MCC closes at 6pm on Sundays. For the tournament, we will have use of the gym, the drinking fountain/filling station and bathrooms across from the MCC Offices. No other facility amenities will be available after 6pm, including the locker rooms. Following the conclusion of the tournament, we ask all players to exit the building as soon as possible.
